- ** DEADLINE: Applications must be received or postmarked by November 7th Applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - Enrolled as a student (graduate or undergraduate) in a degree or certificate program at an accredited institution in Central Alabama.
 - 2. The candidate must be of Caribbean heritage: that is, born in the Caribbean or have a parent, or grandparents who were born in the Caribbean.
 - 3. Satisfy the minimum academic requirement 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
 - 4. Willingness to serve as CACAO Ambassadors to help the mission of CACAO throughout the year. This includes promoting the mission by sharing the Caribbean culture and promoting diversity and inclusion within the community and its surrounding areas.

APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

 Application form (provided on the next page).
A letter of recommendation from a faculty member or mentor.
Most recent college transcript.
An essay about yourself explaining your career goals, what you are studying and why you want to further
your education. The essay should be no longer than 500 words.
